## TECHNOLOGY UPGRADES

Through the generosity of some gifts and your support by participating in various fund-raising events, Faribault Lutheran School is making some very nice improvements in the area of technology.

A digital projector has been ceiling-mounted in the computer lab and connected to one computer. Now, whatever shows on the screen of that computer is projected onto a screen mounted on a wall. **The teachers who are using this love it!**

The next purchase and installation is set to be an interactive white board in one classroom. This will be very similar to the arrangement in the computer lab, except that the teacher of students can control what they see on the screen (in other words, what shows on the computer and is projected) from the front of the room at the white board by touching the white board with either their finger or a special stylus.
