School Lunch Statistics:

The number of school lunches served in Minnesota in the past year was 98,000,000. The percentage of free or reduced-price school lunches served in Minnesota was 38%. The percent of increase in free or reduced lunches during the last three years was 7%. The proportion of lunches served free or reduced is rising steadily each year. The average cost to produce a school lunch is \$2.78. The average cost that schools collect for each school lunch is \$2.48. The average cost per lunch served that schools absorb is \$0.30. School lunch revenue sources are student payments 47%. Federal funding is 45%. State funding is at 4%. During the last year the cost for a half-pint of milk has soared from an average of 14 cents to more than 20 cents, nearly a 43% increase.
