school looking so great before,

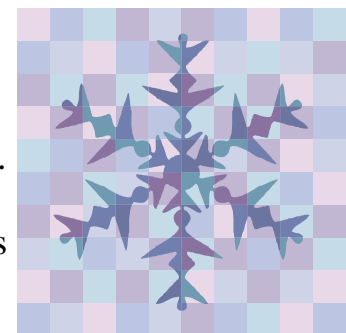
during, and after the tournament. It looked amazing after the tournament!
