Registration for the 2022-2023 School year is now open!

Register before **March 15th** to get the reduced rate of **\$100/student**, the fee moves to it's regular rate of \$250/student after that date.

Tuition for 2021-2022 will be \$3,375 (for 1st and 2nd student)
\$1,687.50 (per additional student)

Technology Fee remains \$50 dollars per student

Tuition Information 2022-2023

Christian education is an excellent investment in the overall cost of raising a child. Financial considerations should not be an obstacle to obtaining this important part of raising your child. The FLS school board is sensitive to the fact that people have different needs in fulfilling their financial obligations, so we are providing the following payment options.

Prepayment

_____ I will prepay my tuition in full by cash or check on or before **August 15, 2022**. I understand that a prepayment courtesy of 5% will be subtracted from the total obligation, bringing my payment to **\$3,206.25 per student.***

Financing.

_____ I will pay my tuition based on a 10 month payment plan. I understand that my first payment will be due by **August 15, 2022** and my final payment will be due by May 15, 2023. My total obligation to the school is **\$3,375.00**, made in 10 monthly payments of **\$337.50 per student.***

_____ I will pay my tuition based on a 12 month payment plan. I understand that my first payment will be due by **July 15, 2022** and my final payment will be due by June 15, 2023. My total obligation to the school is **\$3,375.00**, made in 12 monthly payments of **\$281.25 per student.***

By signing this agreement I acknowledge that a late fee of \$15.00 per month for any payment not made by the last day of each month will be added to my bill. I acknowledge that I understand that any scholarship funds awarded to my family for the school year will be forfeited if tuition payments are not made for two months or more, and we will be responsible for the full tuition payment of \$3,375.

Quick Financial Aid Assessment FAQ

What are the requirements for financial aid?

The financial need evaluation is different for every school and every family. We take into account all aspects of your financial situation during the evaluation.

What documentation will I need to complete the application?

The required supporting documentation will be outlined at the beginning and end of the online application and is tailored specifically to what is entered on your application. Typically, TADS requires your most recently filed 1040 tax form (or verification of non-filing status from the IRS), your most recent W-2 statements, your most recent pay stubs as well as documentation of the stated debt on your application. Other documentation may be required.

How can I send in the supporting documentation?

You may mail, fax or upload your documentation to TADS. We will give you document submission information at the end of the application.

What if I want to leave my online application and come back to it later?

You may log back in to the TADS system and complete the application at any time.

How do I know if you have received my fax, mail or upload?

TADS will send you an email within 48 business hours of receiving your fax, mailed document or upload.

If my circumstances change, can I change my application?

Please call the TADS helpline if you need to adjust your application, a TADS representative will ask for documentation of these changes to be submitted by mail, fax or upload.

Faribault Lutheran Scrip Program

What Is Scrip?

Scrip is a term that means substitute money. When you purchase scrip, you're purchasing negotiable gift certificates and prepaid cards that are used just like cash. You can use scrip to purchase everyday items like food, clothing, gas and other essentials, and with every purchase, you earn revenue for our organization.

How does scrip generate revenue for Faribault Lutheran School?

The Great Lakes Scrip Center acts on behalf of Faribault Lutheran School to purchase large amounts of scrip from grocery stores, department stores, and other retailers - because the scrip is purchased with cash up front, the participating retailers offer a substantial discount. Our local grocery stores, department stores, and other retailers give great discounts as well. Faribault Lutheran School orders the scrip from the Great Lakes Scrip Center and local retailers and restaurants at a discount, and re-sells the certificates to families like yours for full face value. The discount is from two to fifteen percent or more and that is our school's revenue.

Why Scrip fundraisers?

The reason for the effectiveness of scrip is simple: families generate revenue through purchases they would make anyway. Groceries, clothing, toys, gifts, even gasoline can be purchased with scrip. An organization of 150 families easily spends between one and two million dollars per year on food, clothing and other essentials. If these families use scrip for these purchases, they can raise as much as \$40,000 to \$80,000 per year -- without spending an additional penny.

Does it cost a family anything to participate?

There are no membership fees or application fees. The beauty of the scrip concept lies in the fact that you raise money for our school by using your existing household shopping budget. Some families may enlist relatives, friends and neighbors to buy scrip. But unlike other fundraising programs, scrip families do not have to "sell" anything to raise money for our school.

Can I use the scrip certificates anywhere?

Yes, the certificates are accepted at all participating retailer locations. Some restrictions may apply

What retailers are participating in this program?

A list of retailers, local and national, is available from the school office. In addition to national chains, many local businesses participate by accepting Community Scrip.

Where will my contribution be applied?

When you purchase Scrip, 75% of the profit is credited directly to your tuition account. If you do not have a student attending Faribault Lutheran School, you can either designate a current student or ask that the profit be given to the Angel Fund for scholarship assistance. The additional 25% of the profit helps to fund the school's Scrip program.

How does this work?

The discount percentage offered to us by the retailers is the revenue portion of the transaction. For example, you purchase \$100 worth of Old Navy for \$100 (face value) and Kwik Trip gives our organization a 14% discount so the revenue generated from this transaction would be \$14; \$10.50 of the revenue would be applied to the designated account (tuition or scholarship) and \$3.50 would be used to assist the Scrip program itself.

Where will Scrip be available to purchase?

Points of sale may be the school office or at either Peace Lutheran Church or Trinity Lutheran Church on Sunday mornings. Large quantities of certificates and certificates not kept in stock may be ordered.

Where do I get order forms?

Order forms are available at the school office.

Completed order forms are due to the school office by 9:00 am on Monday to be processed that week. Late orders will be held over to the next week. Orders are processed every Monday and will usually be available by Friday. On Monday holidays, the processing will be done on Tuesday. Exceptions may apply at certain times of the year.

You can also order scrip online, through shopwithscrip.com. Please contact the school office for more information and the enrollment code.

How do I pay for my Scrip?

Scrip must be purchased with cash or check and the payment must be made at the time the order is placed. Checks must be made payable to Faribault Lutheran School.
